Requirements of Membership in LLCA Home Education

Membership in Lindsay Lane Baptist Church – The family must be active and in accordance with guidelines set forth in scripture for the family.

Statement of Commitment – simply states that you agree with basic Christian doctrine and that you will instruct this in your home

Church school enrollment form – sent to the board of education for the area in which you live to notify them that your child(ren) are being home schooled with LLCA Home Education (Upon enrollment in cover.)

Student enrollment form – basic information about the student (Upon enrollment in cover.)

Records Release form - if the student has been enrolled in a public or private school elsewhere

Membership in HSLDA (Home School Legal Defense Association) - a nonprofit advocacy organization established to defend and advance the constitutional right of parents to direct the education of their children and to protect family freedoms

Study plan – general plan for what will be taught in each subject and the material to be used (submitted at the beginning of each semester)

Sample lesson plan – 1 week of lesson plans (submitted at the beginning of each semester)

Progress Report – general progress made in each subject (submitted at the end of each semester)

Work samples – copies of student's work in each subject (students earning credits must submit enough samples to show continued work and learning in each subject; other students submit 1 page for each subject) (submitted at the end of each semester)

Attendance - calendar showing days of education; 180 days required which includes education at home, in cooperative learning environments, other classes, field trips, etc. (submitted at the end of each semester)

Transcript - for students earning credits (submitted at the end of each semester)
